




Dear Confreres,





Lent is the time for renewal, reminder, re-examine and retrospection. The 40 days of Lent are to be an imitation of Jesus' 40 days in the desert. It is an inward journey for 40 days searching for an answer to the questions; who am I, what am I and why am I. Chapter 6 of Mark suggests Fasting, Prayer and Alms giving as means to achieve this end. They are the three pillars on which we build the holy season of Lent. These external acts are three dimensional; in relation to God (prayers), in relation to oneself (fasting) and in relation to neighbour (alms giving). It is chain of actions and reactions leading from one to another. Any One of them without the other is hypocrisy and any one

totally disproportional to other is pharisaic. The Lenten observances and traditions make us more reflective. All of these practices help to bear spiritual fruit in our lives. They bring us to a step closer to God.

Prayer: Prayer is communication with God on an interior level. In prayerful communication with God, we speak, talk, argue, plead and we suggest. But above all, we listen, hear, understand and respond. Communication is not a "One Way" traffic. With this understanding we take our prayer to another level of excellence. Fasting: Fasting is something more than controlling our digestive system. It is a matter of taking control over our five senses. Newspaper, Magazine and Radio are entertainment of the past. TV, Computer and Mobile have taken toll our ears and eyes. Our taste buds cannot be satiated with rice and curry but they need now fast-food and junk-food. The smell of an Agarbati may not invoke any sense of devotion in us today because our sense of smell is addicted to expensive scents and perfumes. Almsgiving: Mother Theresa often said "give until it pains you." Giving from affluence and excess is no real giving in Christian sense of the word. Giving should involve cross, suffering and sacrifice. Most of our benefactors are generous with us not because they have plenty but they deny themselves in life something or other so that they can help the needy. We give our five senses a 40 days' break from the soothing delights and delicacies of the world so as to turn to the deeper delights of a life of union with God.

Let us pray in Lent 2020: Lord, I give myself to You this Lent. I freely choose to enter into these 40 days of Lent and choose to pray, fast and give of myself to an extent I have never done before. I pray that this Lent will be a time in which I am transformed interiorly by You. Set me free, dear Lord, from all that keeps me from loving You and others with all my heart. Jesus, I trust in You. Amen

I wish you all a holy season of the Lent and God's rich blessings in all what you do and undertake for the Glory of God and salvation of men.
