- # Please follow strictly the orders, guidelines and recommendations of civil and ecclesiastical authorities of your local areas.
- # Please cooperate with the civil authorities to get the epidemical situation under control.
- # Please take precautionary measures strictly in all our institutions and parishes.
- # Advice people to take precautions.
- # If you need any assistance in taking precautions please contact Fr. Saji George Puthiyakulangara, Director of FAsCE India.
- # Avoid believing and spreading rumours.
- # Avoid travelling unless out of extreme necessity.
- # Reach out to people as much as possible without harming yourself. Take care of yourself first and then the people.
- # If possible, make sure the participation of Sunday Mass through YouTube Channels. Communicate to the people the You Tube links.

- # Some of our people, may be now more than before, in need of financial assistance. Please do whatever is in your capacity to help them.
- # Please celebrate Mass privately without publicity and without the presence of the public.
- # Please pray specially for the people and health workers.
- # Please take care specially of your personal hygiene.

Let us connect ourselves and the people to God. Fears and uncertainties are temporary. The pandemic of corona virus crises, calls for not only clean personal hygiene but also personal purity. The crisis leaves us alone with confusion and doubt. We have to follow a higher path, the path of patience, alertness, courage, understandings and love.
